



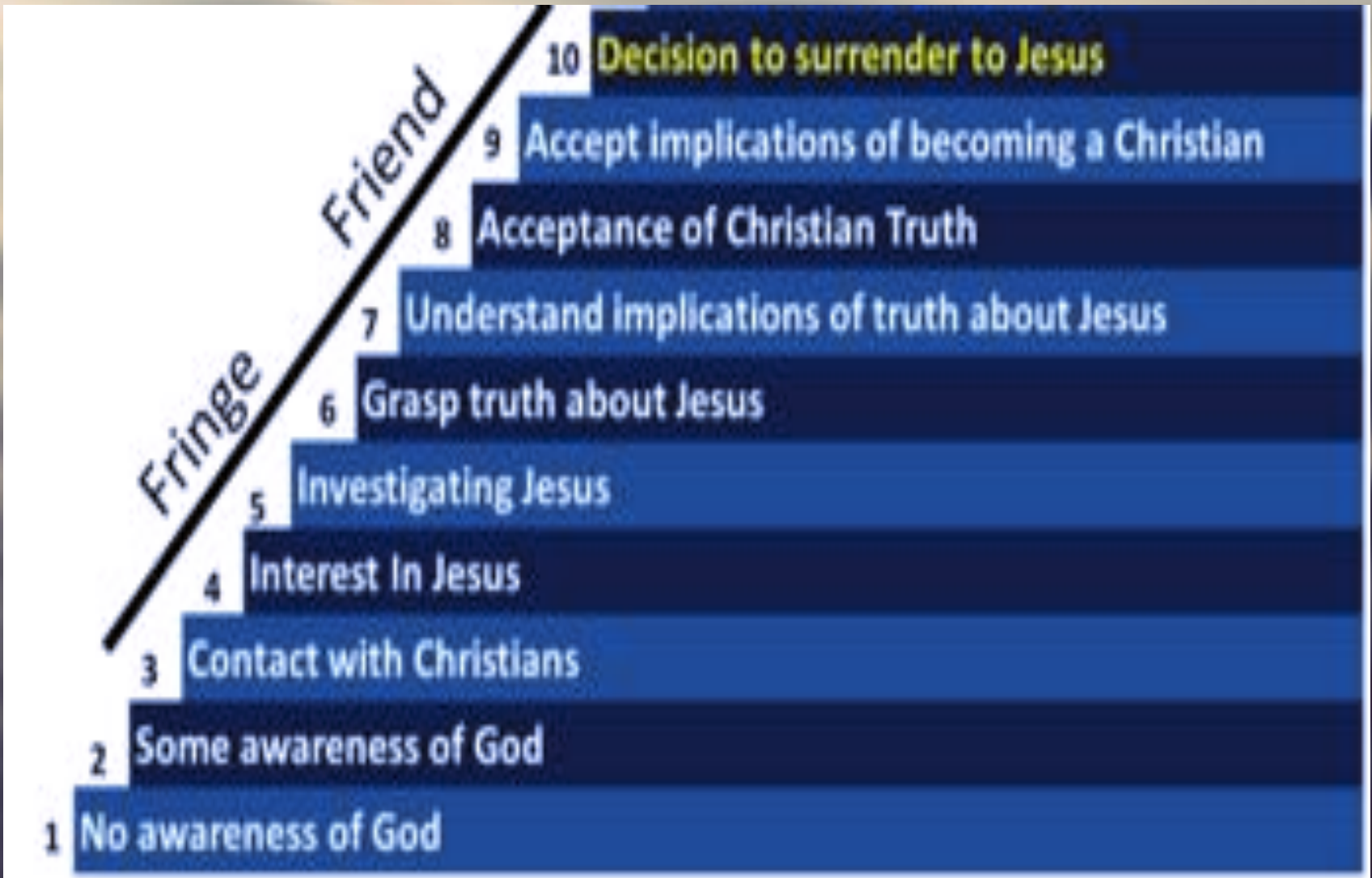

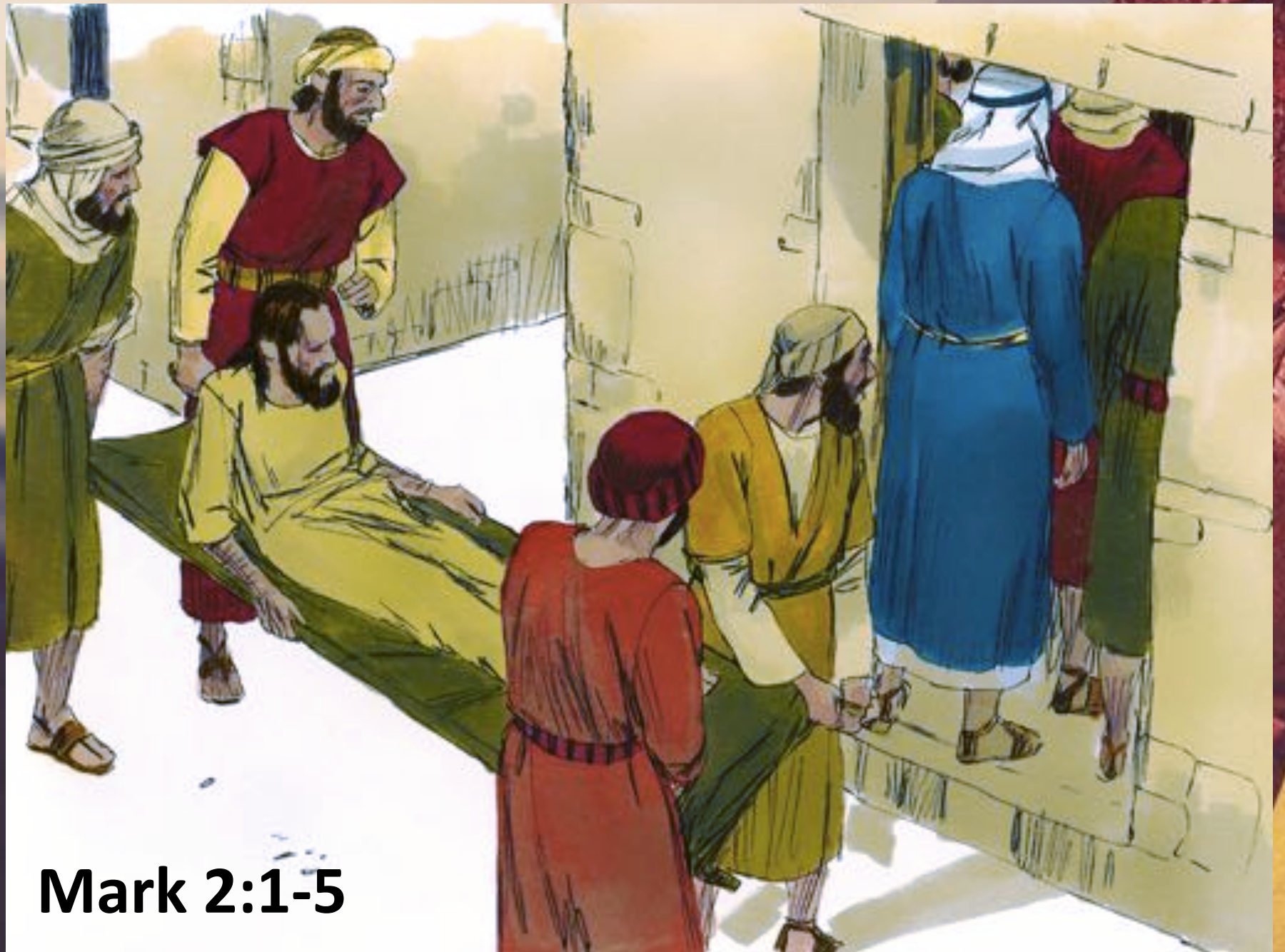

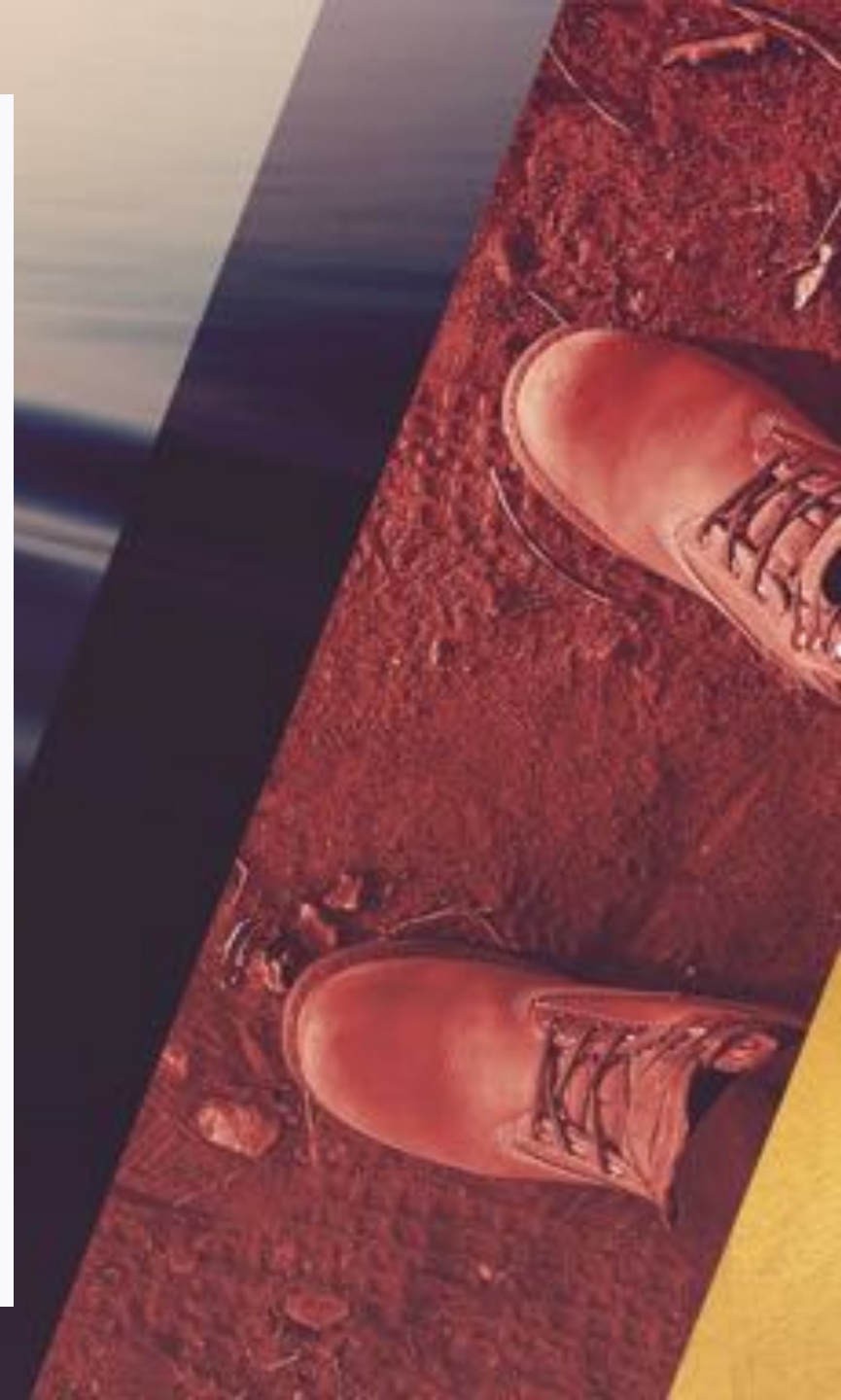
Pray for people in your circle of influence. Pray with them too.

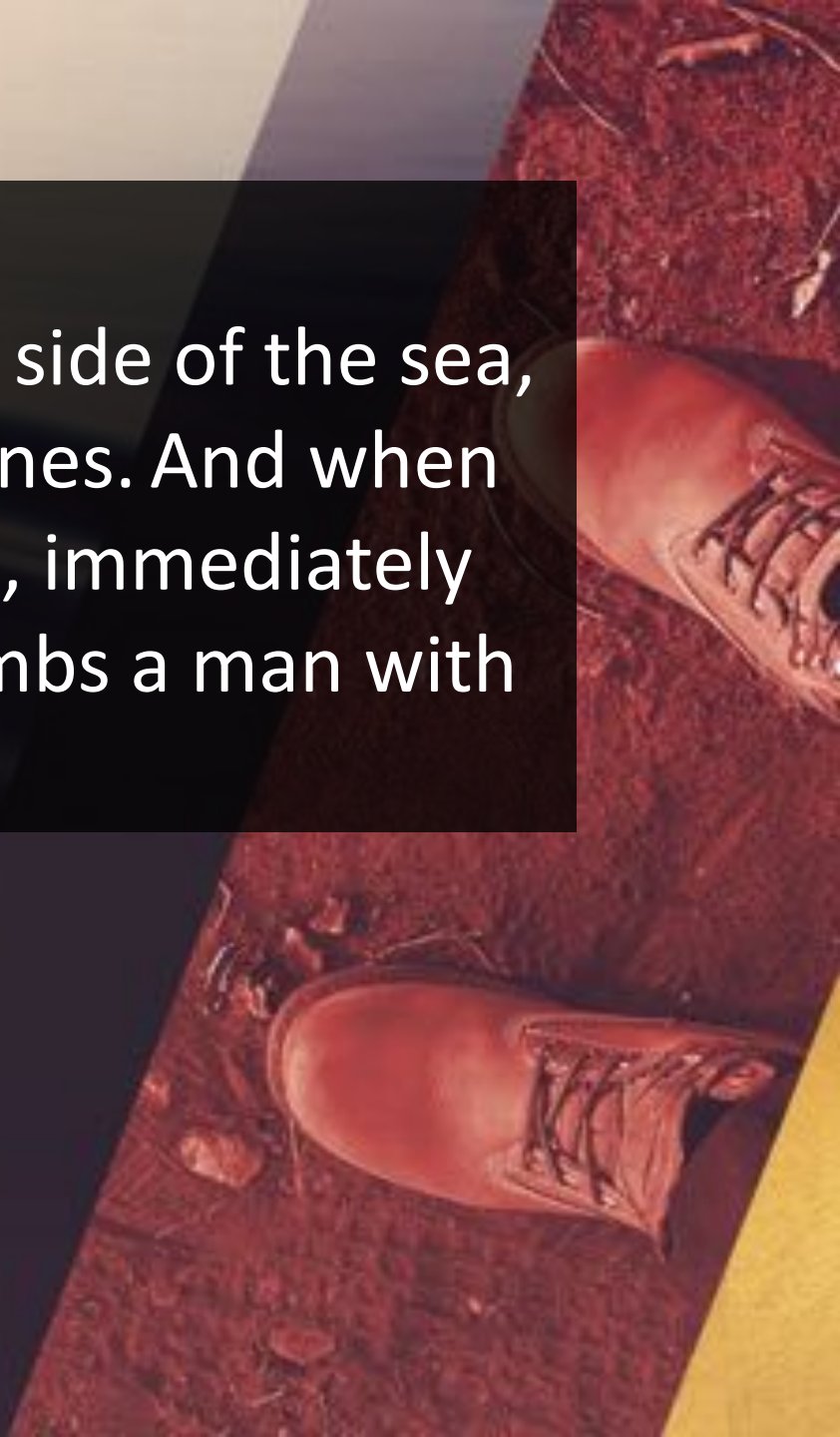
Mark 5:1-15

They have all turned aside; They have together become unprofitable; There is none who does good, no, not one ... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God

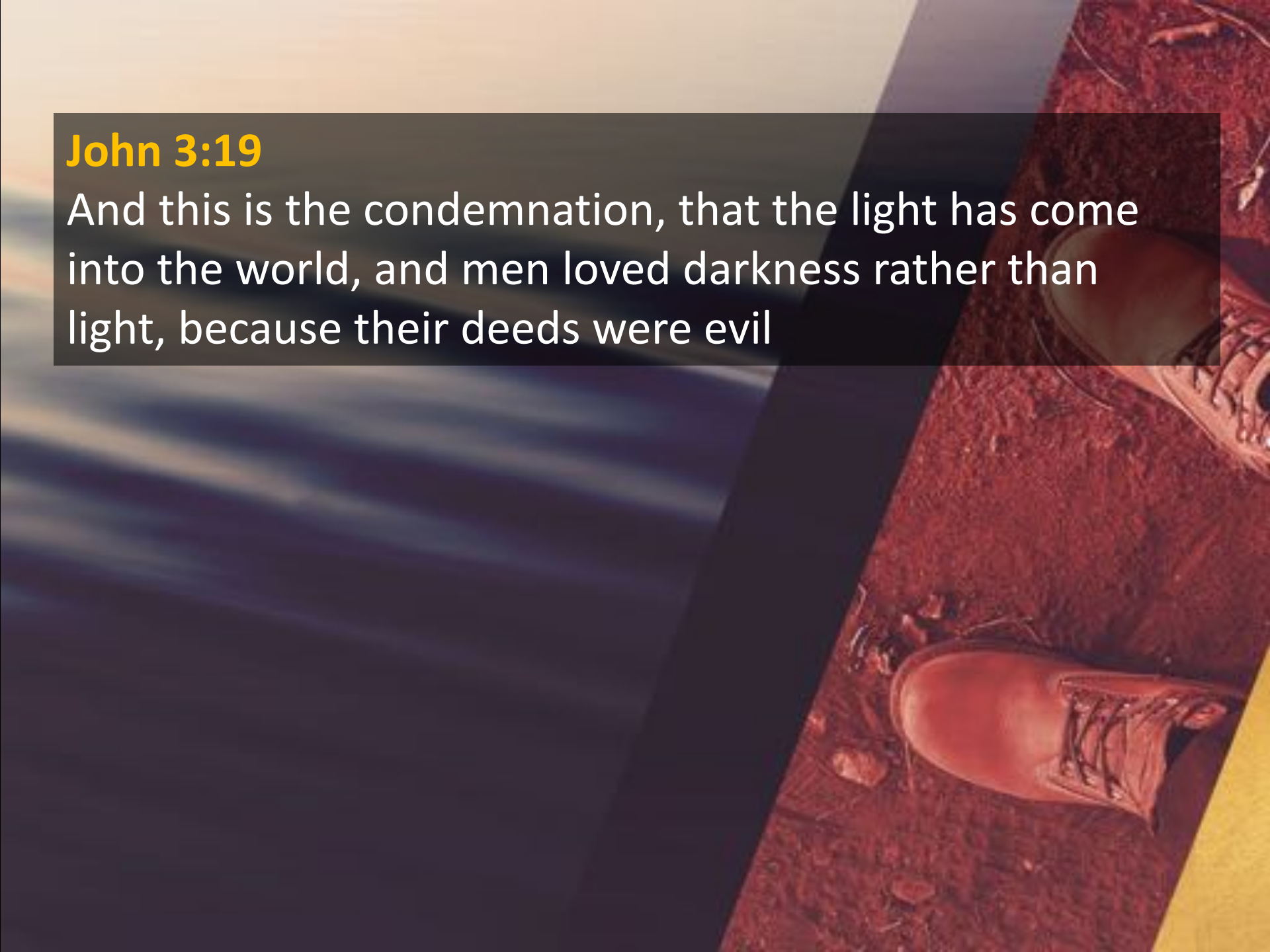
For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ

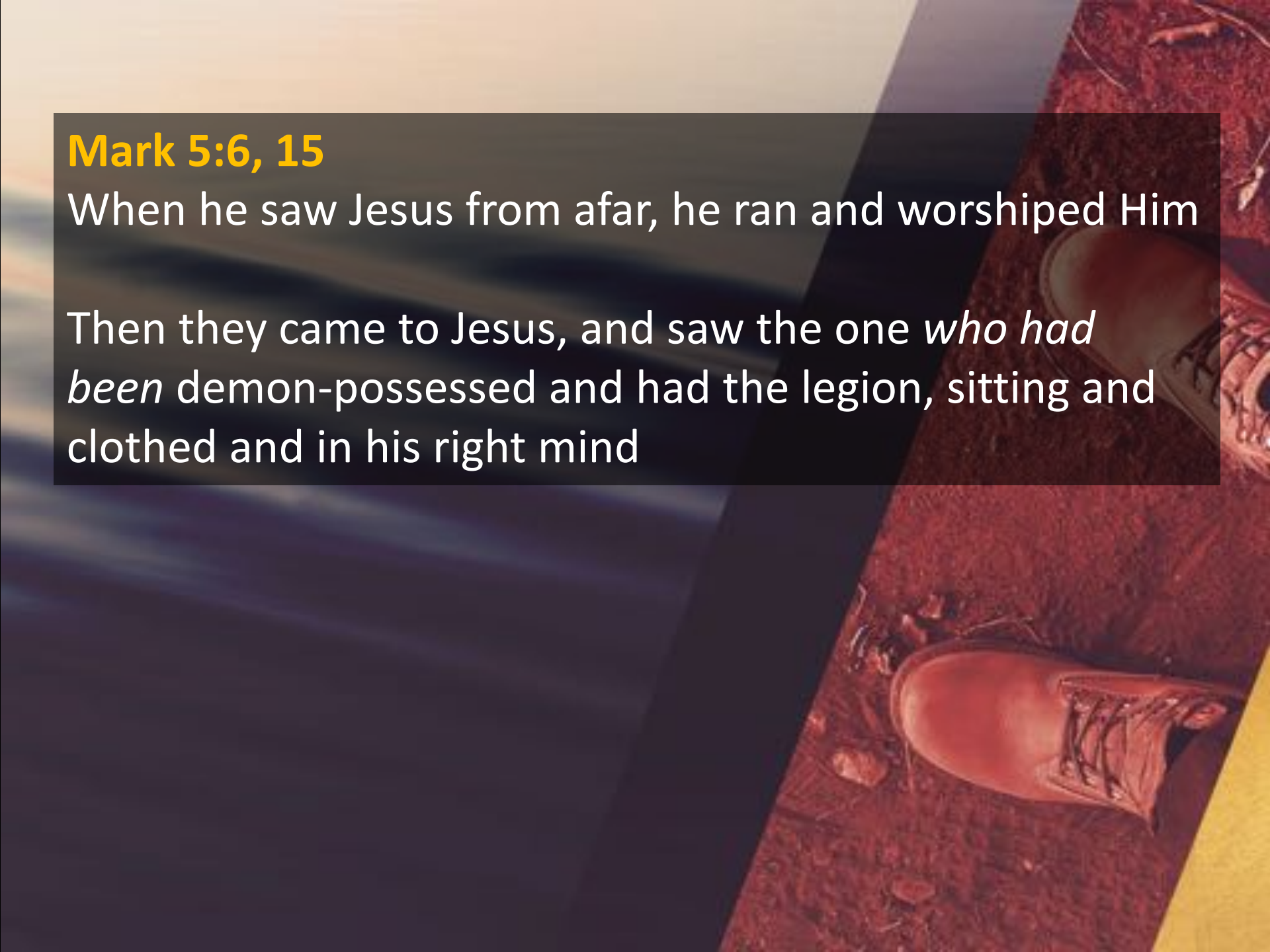
And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil
